- and an OFFICIAL copy (stamped and signed by guidance personnel) of your transcript in a sealed envelope (an unofficial copy of your transcript or an official copy of your transcript that is not in a sealed envelope will be deemed invalid).

DEADLINE: All requested information must be mailed and postmarked on or before **Friday, March 27, 2020**.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- > Cumulative grade point average of **2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale** (10%)
- > Activities (school, community, and religious organization) (40%)
- ➢ Written expression (essay) (20%)
- Recommendations (30%)

ANNOUNCEMENT: The selected scholarship recipients will be announced by **Friday**, **May 1**, **2020**. The recipients will be notified by mail.
